NOTIFICATION OF ROAD WORKS A43 Northbound Syresham / Brackley Hatch / Silverstone, Northamptonshire.

I am writing to inform you that we will shortly carry out emergency essential maintenance work on the A43 between Syresham (B4525) and Wood Burcote (A413) in both directions.

When will this work take place?

The work will take place overnight from Monday, 19 June to Tuesday, 4 July.

The A43 pavement surface condition is deteriorating and in urgent need of repair. We have carried out minor repairs to the carriageway over the last few weeks. During this work, we identified significant sections that are in a very poor condition. We need to repair these immediately to ensure our customers continue to have safe and reliable journeys at this location. Delaying this work could mean the damage gets worse, and more roadworks are needed, for a longer time, to fix resulting problems.

How will it affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, we will need to fully close the carriageway overnight from 8pm to 6am (one hour earlier and one hour later on Saturdays & Sundays), when traffic levels are quieter.

We will close the eastbound carriageway from 19 to 26 June and the westbound carriageway from 27 June to 4 July.

During the closures, we will put in place fully signed diversion routes.

- ➤ For A43 Eastbound closure(s) at Syresham motorists will be directed westbound on the A43 to the A43 / A421 Barley Mow Roundabout turning left along the A421 to the A5 via Buckingham, returning to the A43 via the A5 to Towcester.
- ➤ For A43 Westbound closure(s) at A413 Wood Burcote motorists will be directed eastbound on the A43 to the A5/A43 Tove Roundabout turning right along the A5 through Towcester to Milton Keynes taking the A421 back to the A43 via Buckingham.

The carriageways will remain open on Sunday nights through until Monday morning and we will keep the carriageway open as normal during the daytime.

Please note that all planned roadworks are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. We will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.

I apologise again for the short notice and would like to thank you in advance for your patience during this vital work.
