Length of Project: 10 Days

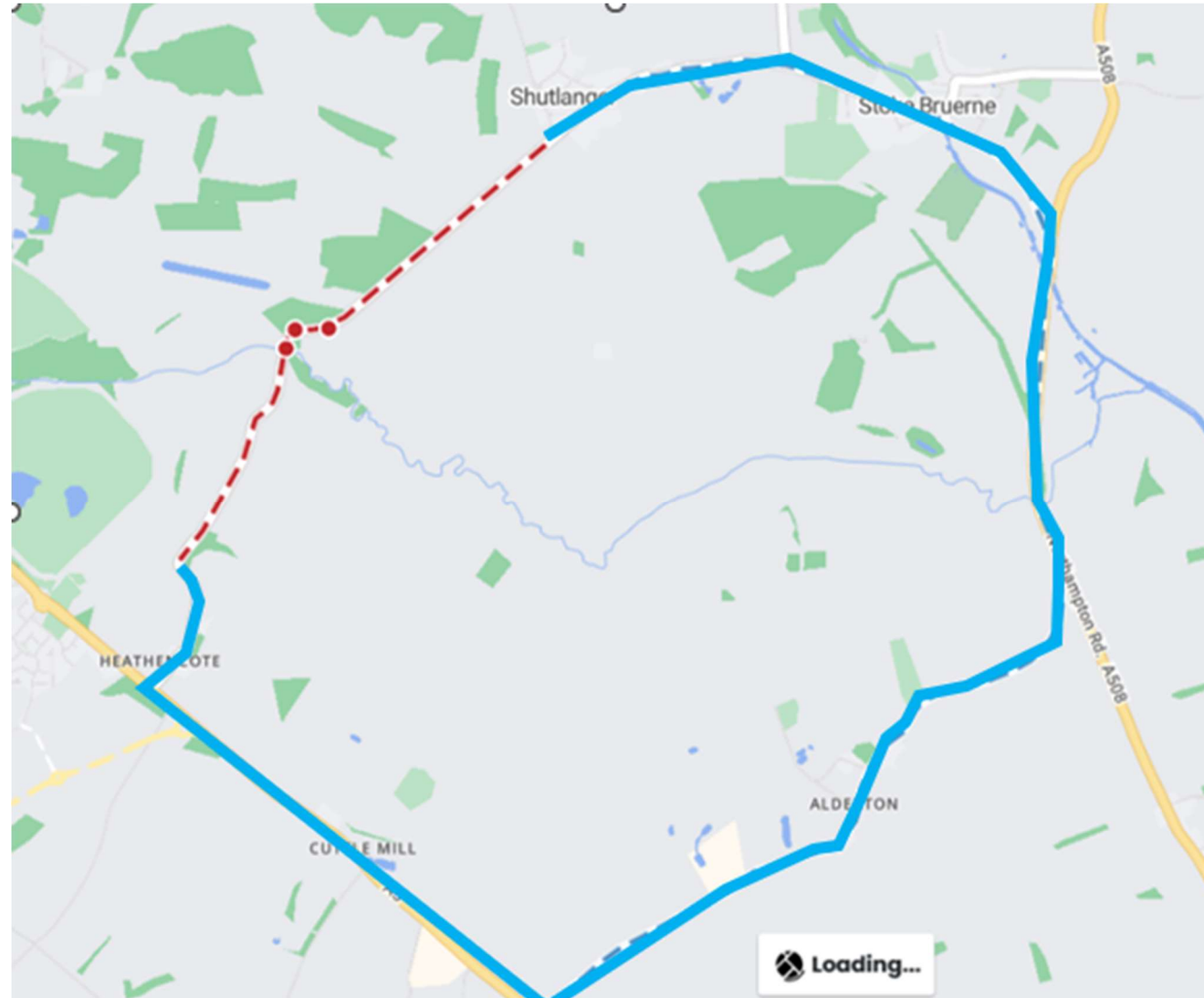
Times: 09:30am – 15:30pm

Traffic Management: A road closure will be in place on Cappenham Road, with an approved diversion route. The **RED** line shows the road closure, and the **BLUE** line shows the extents of the diversion route

Residents: Vehicle access will be limited for residents, please expect minor delays

Emergency Vehicles: We aim to maintain access for emergency vehicles where safe to do so. However, please expect delays.

Public Transport: There will be no bus services through this closure.
